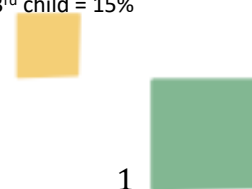

Hygiene Plan

Nursery	€80

The Hygiene Plan is mandatory for children attending **Nursery & Crèche** who are still wearing nappies/dippers. It includes disposable nappies plus all the necessary hygienic products. Once your child becomes fully potty trained, this service will stop. If your child requires any specific hygiene products, these are the parents' responsibility.

Meal Plan

The meal plan is mandatory for all students, with the exception of Nursery children. The meal plan was created thinking of the child's nutritional needs and caters for different dietary preferences, i.e. vegetarian, allergy diet, etc. The aim of the plan is to provide your child with a varied and balanced meal containing elements of each food group. To minimise the possibility of developing allergies, we have opted for a **Nut Free School**; we have also opted for a healthy diet and therefore **no red meats** will be permitted at our school. If for medical reasons your child needs a special diet brought from home, a medical justification is required. However, we ask you to respect our decision of not allowing red meat and nuts in our premises.

The meal plan includes a morning snack, lunch and afternoon snack.

Morning snack – seasonable fruit and bread

Lunch will consist of:

- soup
- fish, meat (white meat only) or vegetarian dish
- dessert (fruit and cake only once a week)

Afternoon snack, choice between:

- bread with a filling (cheese, butter, jam or marmalade), crackers or biscuits
- 1 drink (milk / juice)
- or
- yoghurt and granola

The annual amount for the catering service has been calculated according to the school calendar and has been divided into 11 equal instalments, so that during the period of interruption of school activities it does not entitle you to any refund / change.

Nursery children

Parents must bring their own food preparations (milk, porridge, purees, etc) in accordance to the age and feeding habits of the child. These must be packed in clearly labelled boxes and given to our team, who has been trained to safely handle all food.

Swimming

Swimming is an important activity for all **pre-school** and **primary** school children. We have included it in the academic weekly timetable from October to June (9 months). However, we understand that some children may have underlying medical conditions that preclude them from taking part in the activity. If this is the case and/or you do not wish your child to swim, please opt out in the enrolment form. Children who do not swim will remain at school during the time of the activity.

Lessons take place at Quinta da Marinha Health Club in Cascais.

Swimming fees

€240 per term

This cost already includes transport from and to school provided by a child-safe transport company.

Extended service / afterschool care

Optional extended childcare services are available from **17H to 19H**. For one-time attendance only please advise the school at least 24 hours in advance. During this time, children will have access to the playground and to a supervised room where they can do any homework and/or engage in creative work (drawing, painting, etc.).
